Ronald Darnel Smallwood of Mt. Poconos, Pennsylvania, was born on January 12, 1958 in Paterson, NJ. The oldest child of the late Elizabeth Smallwood-Caldwell and William "Billy" Hardy. Educated in the Paterson Public School, he graduated from John F. Kennedy High School where he excelled in Track and Field. Known as "E Man", he won many 1st place trophies and ribbons.

Ronald attended The University of Virginia, Petersburg, VA, where he pledged and was inducted into the brotherhood of ALPHA PHI ALPHA Fraternity.... he was an ALPHA MAN, as we often heard him sing and saw him step in earlier years.

Ronald worked briefly in the Passaic County Jail and thereafter, enlisted in the United States Army; having served a four year tour, he received an Honorable Discharge.

Ronald was a kindhearted man, with a loving soul, who deeply loved his family and he loved being around family. In spite of his disability, Ronald taught himself how to speak Spanish fluently, how to play the guitar and the organ without any training or formal tutelage. One of his favorite musical pieces that he mastered was "Nadia's Theme", commonly known to many of us as the "Theme To The Young and Restless" soap opera.

He was predeceased by his mother, Elizabeth Smallwood-Caldwell and his sister, Bernadette D. Caldwell.

He leaves to celebrate his life: his father, William Hardy; stepfather, Eugene Caldwell, Sr.; his sister and caretaker, Veronica J. Caldwell-Adams (Perry) of Mt. Poconos, PA; his brothers, Donald C.
