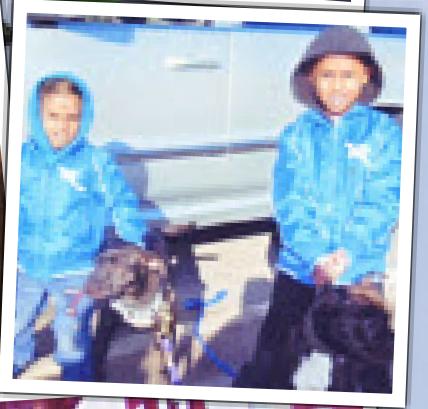
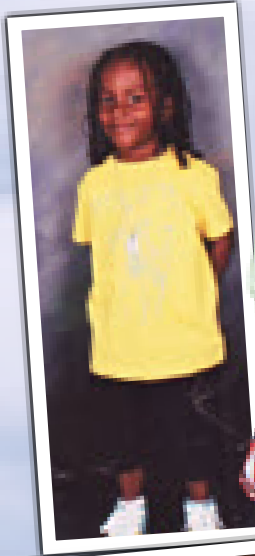
Malik's hobbies included traveling, spending time with his family, training dogs and taking care of them. But what he loved most was watching his kids play and have fun.
