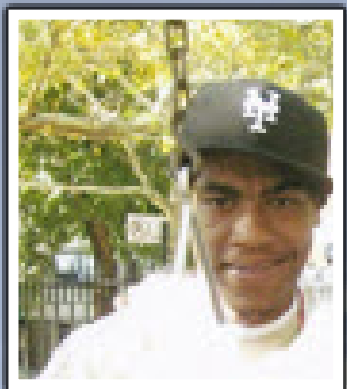

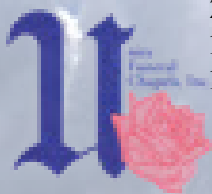
God saw the road was getting rough.
