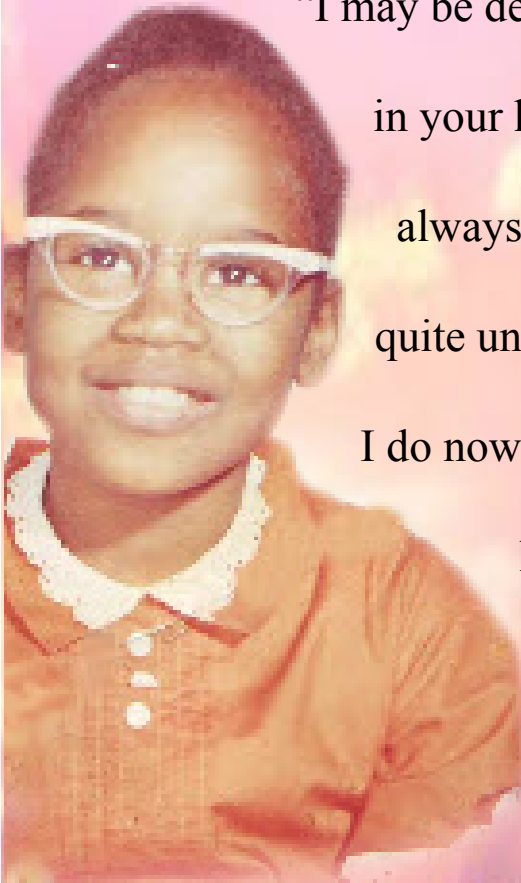
Our loved one, Brenda Williams, went from labor to reward on August 21, 2010 at 4:30 p.m. at home in Aberdeen, NJ.
