Mr. Roosevelt Wright, Sr. was born in Milledgeville, Georgia to the late Mr. Henry and Anna Hill Wright on July 30, 1930. He was the youngest of sixteen children.

He left Milledgeville, GA in 1952 to make Paterson his home. Soon thereafter he met and married Bertha Jones on December 26, 1953. Their union was blessed with seven children, the first child passed at childbirth. He worked at Eureka Printing Co. in Clifton, NJ, also Wllen Chemical and Brown Chemical as a chemical worker from where he retired at the age of sixty-five. He was a loving husband and a caring father, loved and adored in the community.
