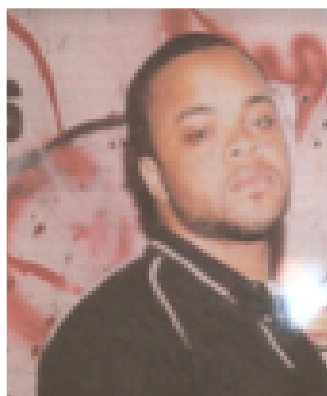
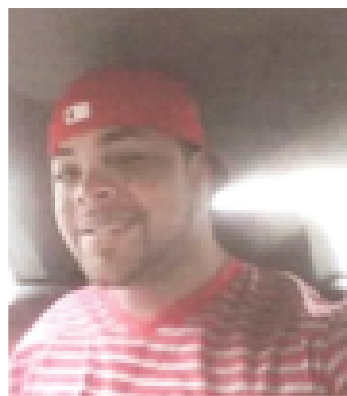


Obituary
