Obituary

Lois Elaine Moore, age 79, of Vauxhall, New Jersey went home to be with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Friday, September 3, 2010.

Daughter and Sister: *Lois, also known as “Bay,” was born on Friday, July 10, 1931 in Newark, New Jersey. She was the second child born to the late George Garfield, Sr. and Nancy Hall (Briggs) Williams--she was sister to George G. Williams, Jr.*

She was Blessed: *During Lois’ early school years, one of her many accomplishments included her mastery of the piano. At the age of six, she attended the New York School of Music where she advanced and excelled in her music studies. She attended and graduated from Monmouth Street Jr. High School in Newark in 1945. Her family relocated to Roselle, New Jersey. She attended Abraham Clark High School where she was a member of the Glee Club and Girls Acappella Choir. She graduated in 1949.*

Wife and Mother: *Lois met and married Charles Moore in 1955 and to this union were born four children; James, Gregory, Richard and Nancy, Jr. (Darlene).*

Mother-in-Law, Grandmother, Great-Grandmother, Aunt, and Friend: *Lois embraced life with a heart full of love. She loved spending time with her growing family—it was all about the love.*

Service and Dedication: *Lois joined Bethany Baptist Church in Newark at an early age. After moving to Roselle, she joined several other churches prior to joining The Aeon Baptist Church, Vauxhall, NJ in 1989, where she was a member of the Walter T. Williams Mass Choir, Pastor’s Aide and served as the Church Sexton.*

After eleven years of service at RCA, Lois took on a position with Merck Sharpe & Dome where she was under the shadow of her father, George. She retired from Merck in 1999 after twenty-five years of service. Since the home life was not quite what she wanted to do, she took on a part-time position as a Bus Aide with the Union Board of Education.

For Every Mountain: *She loved the Lord who was her anchor--He covered and protected her. She had inner strength beyond our understanding. When storm clouds rose in her life and we thought she would fall—He kept her up. There were times when we thought she could go no longer, but the Lord kept her moving. When we thought she was weak—He kept her strong. She could have gone on and on, but God reached out and led her home.*
