Obituary

Ella Lou Whitehead Scott, better known as “**Eddie**”, was born to Henry and Walter Whitehead on November 6, 1917 in Hawkinsville, Georgia. Her mother died at an early age and Eddie’s grandmother, Clifffa Scott, raised her. One of the values Clifffa imparted to Eddie was the importance of family, which became the driving force throughout her life.

On October 6, 1932, Eddie gave birth to her first child, Bernice from her union with Eddie B. Williams. Several years later she met the love of her life, Robert “Bud” Eugene Scott, Jr. and moved north to Connecticut where they both worked as domestics. The new family later settled in The Washington Heights area of New York City where Bud became a baker and Eddie a stay at home wife and mother. On October 8, 1948, Eddie gave birth to her son, Robert Eugene Scott, III. In 1970, she decided to re-enter the workforce and took a job as a housekeeper at the Barbizon Plaza Hotel. Within a few years she rose to the position of Supervisor of Housekeeping.

While Eddie did not have much formal education, she learned on her own and had a wealth of wisdom that she drew on to guide her family. She touched many lives throughout her many years with us. Eddie was the oldest of eight children, Floretta, Bert Lee, Geneva, Henrietta, Anne, Eugene and Walter.

Eddie will be most remembered for all the love she gave all her family and friends, for her feisty sense of humor and her extraordinary cooking. She left us on October 6, 2010, at the age of ninety-two after living a long and fulfilling life.
