Mr. Arnold Warsaw Rose was born in Alexandria, St. Ann, Jamaica, West Indies on November 22, 1914 to the late Arthur and Celestine Rose. He was educated in the Jamaica School system. Mr. Rose came to the United States in 1945. He completed the instruction, became proficient and received his diploma in blue print from Paterson Institute.

When he first came to the United States he worked at Botany Worsted Mill in Passaic. He worked there in 1945 during the Second World War. He had to leave when the men who came back from the war came back for their jobs. Mr. Rose was employed at several other businesses including Major Car Shop in Clifton building box cars, Wallington Resilver New Bell Laundry and Morning Star Paisley Hawthorne where he earned seventy cents an hour. He worked at Morning Star Paisely from 1949 until the factory burned down and was relocated to Brighton Road in Clifton. He retired from Morning Star Paisley in 1974. He then became self-employed doing carpentry, masonry, painting and other odd jobs.

Mr. Rose was a very kind and generous person and was always willing to listen to anyone who had something to say. He was also willing to share his opinion and advice when needed. He became a member of Roger Williams Baptist Church but was unable to attended church due to illness. He was always proud to say he was a member.

He was predeceased by three sisters, Auvlin Rose, Birdie Rose, formerly of Jamaica and Mrs. Esnet Henry, formerly of Bronx, New York, three brothers, Wally Rose, Norvell Rose, formerly of Jamaica and Frankie Rose formerly of Hartford, Connecticut.

Mr. Rose leaves to cherish his memories: one daughter, Mrs. Lorna Johnson (Welton), Clifton, New Jersey; two sons, Aston Rose (Claudeth), Clifton, New Jersey and Lloyd Rose who resides in Jamaica; one surviving sister, Ruby Rose, who resides in Jamaica; nine grandchildren; fifteen great-grandchildren; one great-great grandchildren; several nieces and nephews; and many other relatives and friends.
