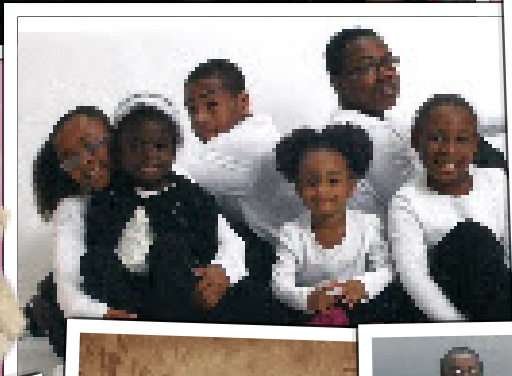
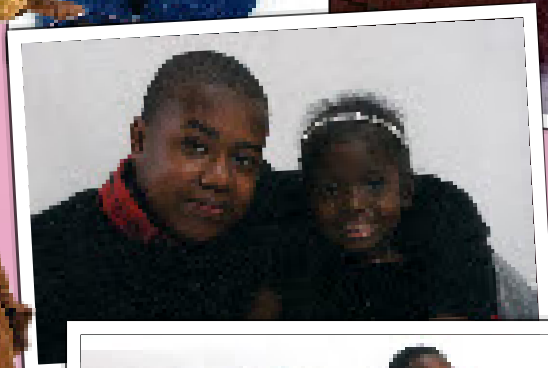
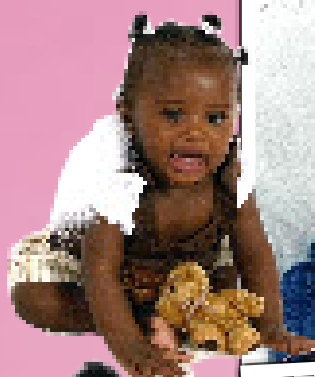
Reflections of Life

Naeemah Nichelle Lee was born January 7, 2006 in Edison, New Jersey at JFK Hospital. God has blessed us with Naeemah for only a brief moment but she touched so many lives while she was here.

At the tender age of four years old, she leaves to cherish her memory: her parents, Carl Parish, father and Ericka Sheree Lee, mother; brothers, Tyrone Davidson and Sharif Parish; maternal grandmother, Patricia E. Lee; paternal grandmother, Deidre Williams; godmother, Rhonda Herring; and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.

Naeemah was diagnosed at two-and-a-half years old with Leukemia. During the last year-and-a-half, she fought with everything she had, enduring nine months of chemotherapy and two bone marrow transplants. Naeemah dreamed of living and pushed herself with sheer will to do the things she wanted to do. For example, she talked about going to school for an entire year. This year on September 17th. Naeemah started Woodroads Elementary. She asked her mother to buy her a Halloween costume three months ago, and Naeemah mustered up the strength through immense pain to go "trick or treating" with her cousins two days before she passed. Her strength was often expressed clearly in her words or the "the look." Naeemah's spirit will last forever in the words that she spoke.
