## <u>Life Reflections</u>

**Jeanette Lorraine Hubbard-Lewis** was born on June 11, 1943 in Blakely, Georgia in Early County to the late Mrs. Senella Hubbard and the late Mr. Willie S. Hubbard, Sr.

Ms. Lewis heard the summons from her heavenly father then petitioned the father to grant some farewell time to family and friends. She accepted the summons on December 18, 2010 to go home to her heavenly father.

Jeanette received her elementary and high school education from Washington High School in Blakely, Georgia. She attended Morris Brown College, Atlanta, Georgia for two years, then entered nursing school prior to migrating to New Jersey.
