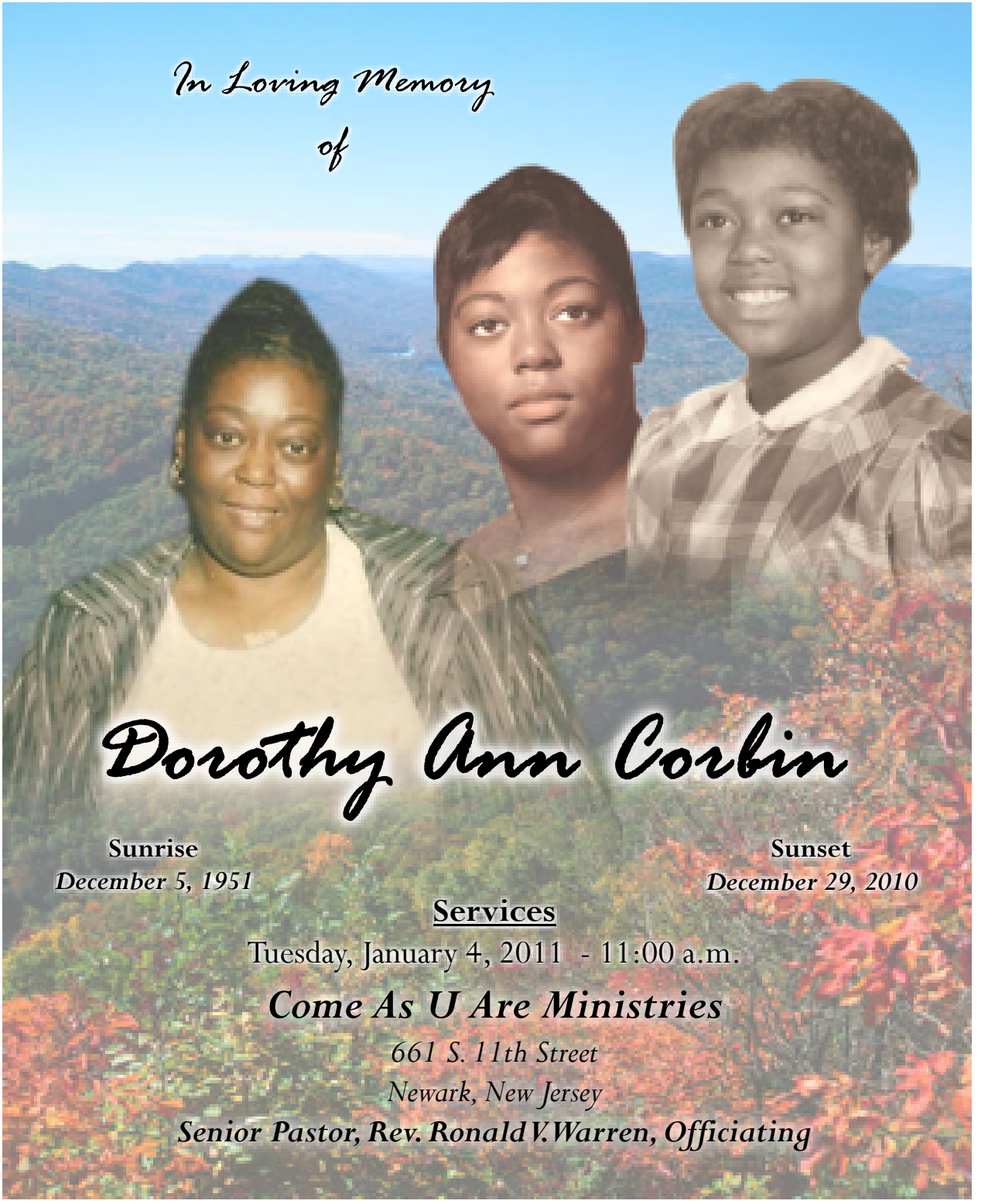

## Obituary



**Dorothy Ann**, better known to family and friends as "Ann" was born December 5, 1951 to Elijah and Dorothy Warren in Eufala, Alabama.

That is when she decided to rejoin the workforce. She held several jobs over the course of fifteen years, until an on the job injury, led her to resign in July 1999.

Ann loved family and God and the last year and half she rededicated her life to the Lord and was an active member and church mother of Come As U Are Ministries, a role she took seriously and loved very much. Ann could be found many times living out the scripture "I won't complain".

Ann's time with us was short and her life ended much too soon when God decided to take her home on Wednesday, December 29, 2010. She is going to truly and genuinely be missed and I know she is sitting amongst the angels smiling down at us.

Ann was preceded in death by her parents, Elijah and Dorothy Warren and baby sister, Viola.
