Life Reflections

Ida Mae Jones Mc Kinney, daughter of the late Mattie Clanton Jones and Samuel Jones, Sr. was born in Enfield, North Carolina about twenty miles from Rocky Mount on May 18, 1928.

Ida attended elementary and high school in Weldon, North Carolina and was a graduate of Fayetteville State Teachers College in North Carolina and Kean College in Union, New Jersey where she received her Master's degree. She had attended many workshops in North Carolina, New Jersey, Washington, DC and Texas.

She was a teacher for the Newark Board of Education for thirty-four years and was employed as a teacher for the Harriet Tubman Elementary School for twenty of those years, retiring on May 1, 1995. After retiring she became a School Bus aide for Vogel Bus Company in Linden, New Jersey for fifteen years. She served as Head Start Director and Teacher for the Linden Board of Education during the summer months.

Ida Mae was a faithful member of Antioch African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church, Linden for twenty-five years. She was the secretary for the Quarterly Conference. She served on the Steward Board, Missionary Society, Class Leader, Superintendent and teacher of the Sunday school.

Ida enjoyed spending time with her family whom she loved unconditionally and serving her church. She was known as the "neighborhood watch" of Middlesex Street.

Ida Mae Jones Mc Kinney departed this life on Tuesday, January 4, 2011 at Trinitas Regional Medical Center in Elizabeth, New Jersey at the age of 82. She was predeceased by her husband, Charles David McKinney, Sr., her children, "Baby" Charles Mc Kinney, Darryl, Michael, Deborah and Charles McKinney, Jr.

Surviving are two brothers, James Jones and Lloyd Jones, Sr. of Halifax, North Carolina; one sister, Margaret L.
