## <u>Obituary</u>

Upon her retirement she became a volunteer for Holy Name Hospitals Hospice Care for many years until she was physically unable to volunteer any longer. She was an avid reader and was passionate about her gardening. Geneva loved to cook but she knew that cooking was not her forte. Geneva loved a good heated discussion and was a skilled debater with a quick wit.

Geneva closed her eyes and parted from life with us to embark on a new journey on January 10, 2011.

She leaves to cherish her memory: her sons, Joshua Edward Spears, IV; his wife, Jessica and children, Kyle W. Lewis, Jocelyn E. Spears and Joshua Edward Spears, V and Schuyler King Spears; and a host of nieces and nephews.
