LaMarr was a lifelong resident of Paterson, NJ before moving to South Carolina three years ago. He was educated through the Paterson Public School system, attending School #26 and Eastside High School. LaMarr wanted to further his education and he did so by attending St. Paul's College in Lawrenceville, VA for two years. LaMarr was employed by the Honda Corporation in Timmonsville, SC as an Engine Assembler.

"Butch," as we called him, definitely lived up to that name. He was a dedicated, bossy big brother... but we loved him just the same. Under all the toughness, Butch was the most caring out of all the siblings. He had a kind heart and would always check on family and friends to give advice, lend a hand or to just tell somebody what to do and how to do it! He was the typical "Carter" man.

Under all the thick skin, LaMarr had a passion for cooking which he learned from his mom. He was known for his outstanding dishes such as stuffed cornish hens, BBQ beef ribs and smothered chicken to name a few. He would then top them off with the family's famous "Company Cake," a recipe passed down from generation to generation.

LaMarr had one child, Tiffany Ann LaRae Carter, whom he loved dearly. He was a proud father when she was born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1989. LaMarr was very close to both Tiffany and her mom, Ella Rouse.

LaMarr was predeceased by his parents, Dorothy and Alfred Carter; his paternal grandparents, Alberta and Ned Carter, and his maternal grandparents, Emma Jones Woodford and David Jones.

He entered into eternal rest on January 30, 2011 in Dillon, South Carolina from a fatal car accident.


