Alphonse Fitz-Patrick Augustin was born on August 7, 1934, at 241 Forshaw Street, Queenstown, British Guyana, to the late Alexandrina Mabel and Alphonse Roderick Augustin. He was the first of seven children born to that union.

He attended mainly private schools at the elementary and secondary levels. First, the Stevens Elementary School and the Ketley Memorial High School in Georgetown, British Guyana, and then the Osmond Boys High School in Trinidad where he completed his formal education. In 1951, his parents and siblings returned to the then British Guyana.

His attraction to law enforcement and security caused him to enroll in the then British Guyana Volunteer Force, the precursor of the Guyana Defence Force. He enjoyed playing the guitar and the harmonica and listening to music, mainly R&B and instrumental, Nat King Cole, and the Drifters who ranked high on his list.

In 1963, he married Joyce Shaw and from that union came one daughter, Elizabeth Patrica.

He migrated to the United States in 1975 where he was reunited with those siblings who lived in the New Jersey/New York areas. He worked at Fidelity Bank and Overlook Hospital in the Security department.

In October 1981, he married Sheila Batson and from that union came a son, Abraham John.

After the latter marriage ended, he returned to Guyana in 2002 and married Winifred Blackman, the mother of his three children: Paul Andrew, Rhonda Olive Petal and Adam Clayton.

He was very proud of his children and was happy to introduce them to whom ever was in his presence.
