Il avait 84 ans.

Retired Military Officer First Lieutenant **Pierre Rene Garcon** was called into eternal rest on March 3, 2011 at East Orange General Hospital in East Orange, New Jersey. Rene was born to Fiette Garcon and Camille Gachette in Gonaives, Haiti (W.I.). He was 84.

Rene has been a devoted person all of his life. He provided for his immediate family and more. He knew the true meaning of work for he has done it continuously without ever taking a real vacation. He entered the Armed Forces as a mean to an end; however, he found love in serving. He was a beloved Drill Instructor, a Mess Sergeant, an Armorer, but most of all, an officer. From 1959 to 1961, he was deployed to San Diego, California as part of an elite team of Haitian Servicemen to receive specialized training with the US Marines. He cherished those years and he always told us about “esprit de corps” and camaraderie which exist among the team. Soldiers he has trained always spoke highly of him.
