

## Obituary

**Doris Evelyn Buckman Ford** was born to the late Rev. Malliaque and Bertha Williams Buckman in Newark, NJ on April 21, 1929.

Doris graduated from Central High School in Newark and furthered her education at the Newark College Preparatory School in Newark, NJ.

She was married to Rev. Dr. Jeremiah Ford on January 28, 1967 and was given a son by the Almighty God.

She started working at a early age for a neighbor first, then Floyd Bostic Cleaners, Cadet Cleaners, Picatenny Arsenal, Lawyer Herbert Tate, City of Newark Controllers Department, The US Government OSHA and EPA.

She sang in groups and also played for several churches. To name a few Prof. Robert Banks Ensemble, The Turner Four, George Davis Singers, The Buckman Trio, The Buckman Aires, Tabernacle Baptist Church, Zion Baptist, Mt. Hermon Baptist Church and others. Doris for several years belonged to the Abatenjwa Alliance of Ministers Wives and Ministers Widows holding offices of President, Vice President as well as First Secretary and Founder. She was also one of the founders of the Christian Fellowship Missionary Baptist Association, and the First Correspondence Secretary. Mt. Hermon had the opportunity to have Doris be the one to name the Women's Department "The Woman's Guild" and she was president for many years. She also organized the Youth for Christ and instituted the College Fund. She served as the secretary of the Sunday School and was the one to encourage the re-survival of the Nurses Unit.
