Mother Eloise Brown fell asleep in the Master's arms on April 10, 2011 at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, Rahway, New Jersey. She was born on January 16, 1922 in Boone Hill, North Carolina to the late Charles and Sarah Spells. She was one of twelve siblings. She also attended school in North Carolina.



In 1941, she moved to Montclair, New Jersey and in 1945 she relocated to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where she met the late Elder R.L. Brown. In 1950, she moved to Rahway, New Jersey where she was united in marriage to Elder Brown. In 1957, she was saved and filled with the Holy Ghost under the late Elder Robert L. Bragg. In 1959, she became a member of Gethsemane Church of God in Christ in Newark, New Jersey where she was loyal and faithful for twenty-four years.
