<u>Obituary</u>

Leon Ernest Gaillard was born to Ernest and Helen Gaillard on September 2, 1924 in the Bronx, New York. As a child, Leon attended New York City Public Elementary and High School. Leon later enrolled and graduated from New York City Community College.

In 1943, Leon enlisted in the US Army. During his tour of duty his decorations and citations included the European-African-Middle Eastern Service Medal, The Good Conduct Medal and the Word War II Victory Medal.

Leon was a valued civil service employee from 1947 to 1979. He retired from the New York City Transit Authority. Leon also worked as a Federal Protective Officer at 26 Federal Plaza, New York.

In the late 1950's, Brother Leon Muhammad accepted the teachings of The Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad and joined the ranks of the Fruit of Islam (F.O.I.). In the Nation of Islam, under the leadership of The Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan, Brother Leon held an outstanding record of sacrifice, service and commitment. He served as a Lieutenant to Captain Yusuf Shah and also as Investigator under St. Captain Richard Muhammad. Brother Leon received many service awards, most notably Believer of the Year and the Pioneer Award. None can deny that as a soldier, Brother Leon walked his post perfectly.

On August 14, 1987, Leon married the love of his life Frances Jones who also accepted the teachings of Messenger Elijah Muhammad. Together Brother Leon and Sister Frances enjoyed life. They were both pillars of their community. Always willing to offer service, charity, and council to those in need. They both loved their family and loved their Nation.
