

## <u>Obituary</u>

Ronald Clayburn Young affectionately known by friends and family as "Ron" or "Ronnie" was born August 13, 1949, in Cleveland, Ohio. Despite having a successful business, Ronald decided to rejoin corporate America. In 1998, he took up employment at UPS where he worked for 13 years as a senior computer analyst.

As a teenager he would hang out at the jazz mobile in Central Park where he would often join in jam session with jazz greats such as Thelonious Monk, Dizzy Gillespie and Miles Davis.
