Obituary

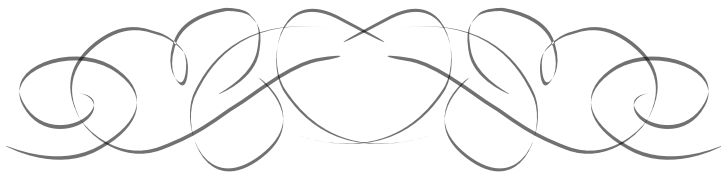
Frances Delores Floyd departed this life on November 22, 2011.
