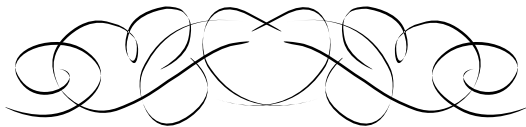
## *Memoir*

**Eileen White-Bradshaw** was the eldest of seven children born to Stella White and Martinez Rollins on May 19, 1928 in Christ Church, Barbados and died on Thursday, December 8, 2011 in Newark, New Jersey, USA.

Eileen attended St. Christopher Elementary School for Girls, Christ Church, Barbados. She worked as a shop assistant and later at Seawell International Airport in catering and food preparation. She subsequently gave birth to Lionel and Victor White. In 1959, Eileen was married to Edmund Arthur Bradshaw. To this union, Emde and Andrea were born.

In 1970, Eileen migrated to the USA, followed by her husband and children. She worked as a housekeeper in a family residence and later at a West Orange Nursing Home till retirement in 1995. Her health deteriorated and in 2008, after home care, her days were spent in a care facility.
