Dr. Dudzayi Dexter Madziwa, Ph.D was born in Mutendebvure in Makoni District, in Zimbabwe, to David Madziwa and Florence Muliba on August 2, 1959. He attended Mutendebvure Primary School in Rusape, as well as primary school in Mutare and Zimonya. He then went on to secondary school at St. Augustine's Mission. From St. Augustine's, he entered the University of Zimbabwe where he obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Politics and Administration in 1982.

In 1983, Dudzayi entered the Zimbabwe foreign affairs ministry and served his country as a diplomat in Berlin, East Germany. This was followed by service in Sweden before Dudzayi resigned to start his own business in New York, USA. While serving his country as a diplomat, Dudzayi found time to pursue his passion for learning by obtaining a Master's degree in Public Administration in 1996 and a Ph.D a year later.

Dudzayi is survived by: his children Kudzai, Kudakwashe, Ngonidzashe, Takunda, Tafadzwa, Tinashe, Munashe and Trina. At the time of his death Dudzayi was in a relationship with Ms. Charity Mfute and lived with her and her son, Tinovimbanashe (Tino) along with daughters, Tinashe and Munashe.
