At the age of eighteen, she moved to Concourse Village where she was known as feisty, spunky, outspoken, well dressed but always active Community Board Member.

In 1988, she married Robert John Pettaway, and from that union bore her only child, Dejonae Pettaway. While raising Dejonae she was adamant about the importance of education and went back to school at the College of New Rochelle where she earned a Bachelors in Criminal Justice. She worked for the NYPD for ten years, Lincoln Hospital for several years and most recently the Bureau of Investigations for the NYC Human Resources Administration. With a keen sense of intuition she always knew what was going on, was revered for her business aura and exemplified the power of the pen with her writings. She used her talents to help any and everyone, and she had a special interest in empowering her community through literature.

Tammy loved to go out to eat and travel, most recently going on a cruise this past October with close family members where she "had the time of her life!" All her life she struggled with her chronic asthma, and on January 9, 2012 Tammy was called home after a battle recovering from a fatal asthma attack.
