Irma was born March 5, 1943, Paterson, New Jersey to the late Deacon Roosevelt and Mattie (Eaton) Gilchrist. She was one of eleven children.

Irma received her formal education, Paterson Elementary School: Central High School and Passaic County College, Paterson, New Jersey.
