Obituary

Born in Cap-Haitien, Haiti on May 13, 1939 to Hector and Françoise Louis, Ghislaine was known affectionately as "Lorlotte" and "Gigi" to her relatives and friends. With her warm and engaging personality, she was a faithful wife, a loving mother, a caring relative, a great friend and a dedicated employee.

She started her working life in Haiti as a teacher in several schools in Cap-Haitien and Saint-Raphael. Married to Marcel Beaubrun on October 27, 1968, Gigi and her husband left their home country soon after for Goma, Zaire where they both worked as teachers. With their adventurous spirit, the young couple put their cap for America and settled down in New York City, in 1969. A few years later, she gave birth to her first son, Lesly in 1971 and in 1975, she gave birth to her second son, Marc-Eric. She also adopted another son, Ronald.

Upon her arrival in New York, she started a lengthy career as a Nurse's Assistant at Bridgeview Nursing Home, in Queens. Along the way, she suffered the death of her husband, Marcel in 1986 and raised singlehandedly her two sons. After 33 years of stellar service, Gigi retired from Bridgeview in 2005.

Beginning 2009, Gigi suffered several serious medical setbacks until she was finally called home on Sunday, March 18, 2012. Her kindness was her signature and her light touched all who were in her presence. Ghislaine is survived by her sons, Ronald, Lesly and Marc-Eric Beaubrun, her daughter-in-law, Robyn, her grandson, Myles, her siblings, Marie-Therese Gabriel, Jean-Claude, Joseph and Eddy Louis, several nephews and nieces and many other relatives and friends. She will be sorely missed by many.
