Solid Rock Baptist Church, where he preached and was once a member, Christ Temple Baptist Church, where he served as pianist of the Male Chorus, Serenity Baptist Church, where he taught Bible study, Reborn Deliverance Center, Bible Way Holiness Church, Star of Hope Ministries, and Reform Church of God. Elder was always ready and willing to proclaim the goodness of God unto the children of mankind.

Elder Kohn was married to the late Mother Mary Francis Kohn for forty two blissful years. He was the father of the late Robin Diane Kohn, Shawna Clarice Kohn, Edwin Clarence Kohn, and Gerald Dail-Kohn. He was blessed with a son-in-law Robert Jackson, and a daughter-in-law Geraldine Tate. Elder had several hobbies such as baking, cooking, singing and playing the piano, and most of all reading the unadulterated Word of God.
