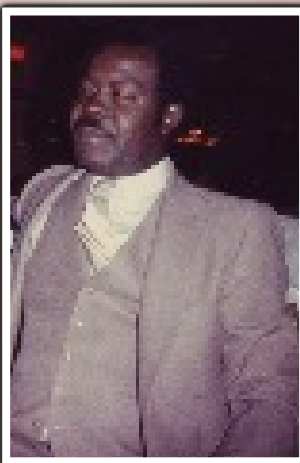


Pallbearers
