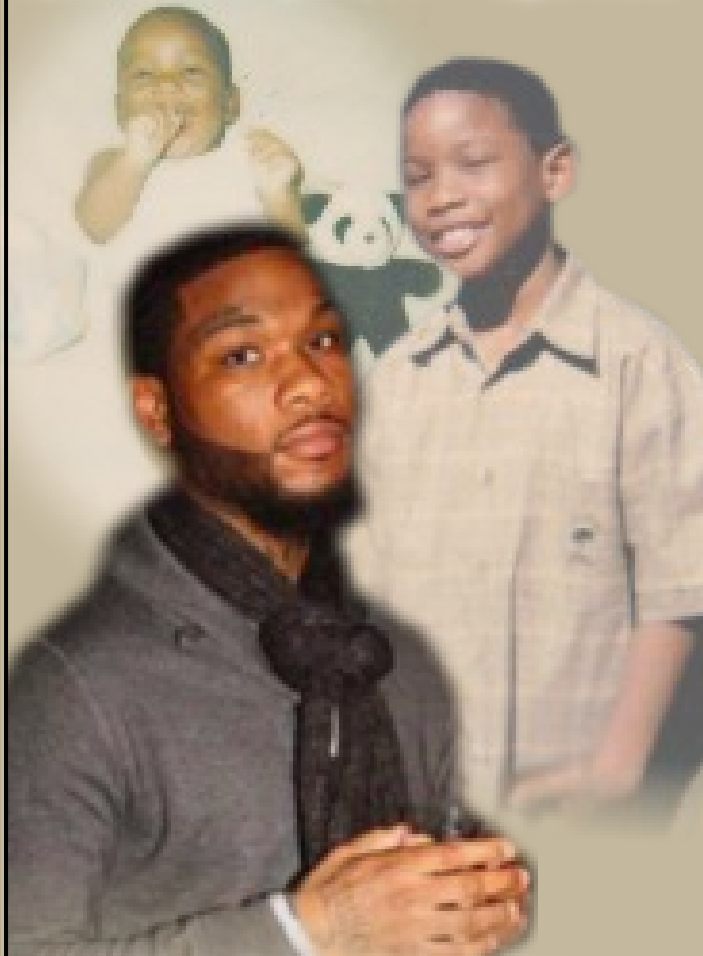



Robert departed this life on August 7, 2012. He was a lifelong resident of Newark, NJ and was educated in the Newark Public School System.

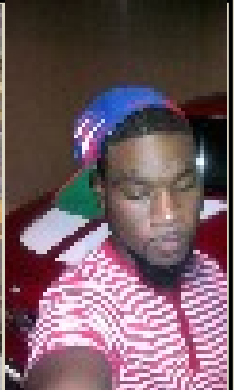
