## Reflections of Life

**Frances (Creed) Wilson Davis** was born March 7, 1921 in Leesville, SC. She was the daughter of Tommie Creed and Bessie (Owens) Creed Wilson.

She received her primary education in the Passaic School System graduating from Passaic High School Class of 1939.

Frances was the first African American to become employed as a telephone operator by the NJ Telephone Co Passaic in 1946.

Upon her marriage to Lester Davis Jr. in 1957 she relocated to Brooklyn NY. It was here she would become employed by the NY Telephone Co. During her years of service she would rise through the ranks to management positions by the time she retired in 1982.

Frances began her Christian journey at the Mt. Zion Baptist Church Passaic under the leadership of the Rev. J. R. Cooper.

She was one of the organizers of the Mt. Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Church Passaic. In later years she attended the Emmanuel Baptist Church Brooklyn, NY.

Frances was an AVID doll collector. Collecting dolls was a great part of her life. Where there was life there was Frances Davis with her unique walk and unique way of talking.

Frances <u>personified</u> a loving personality to everyone she met. Never did she give a sad face. On Wednesday October 10, 2012 God's angels looked down and knew it was time for her to come home at the age of ninety-one. A full life well lived that has now come to a close.

She was preceded in death by a brother Edgar Wilson Jr., Stepfather Edgar Wilson Sr., niece Sarah Lawrence.

She is survived by: her sister, Dorothy W. Lawrence of Lyndhurst, NJ; niece Alisa B. Johnson; eight grandnieces and nephews; special friends, Barbara and Lou Meisel; she was NaNa to Kristen Gilbert. Also surviving are other relatives and loved ones.
