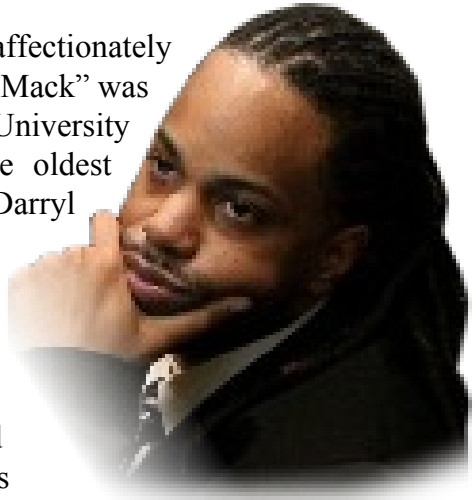
Darryl was raised in Newark, NJ and attended the Newark Public School system where he grew a love for music, cars and video games. Darryl loved his children and his family deeply.
