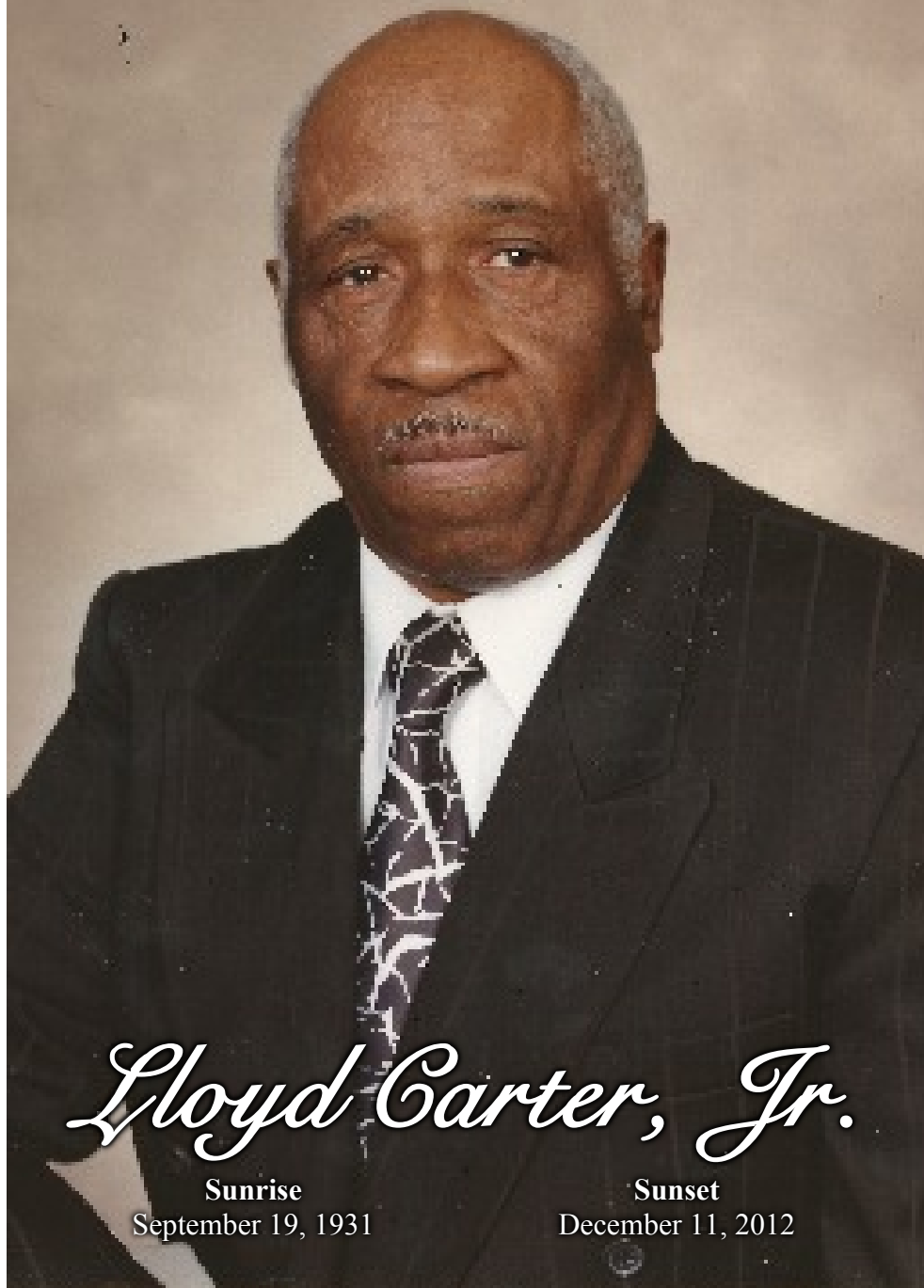

Reflections of Life

Lloyd Carter, Jr. was born in Passaic, New Jersey September 19, 1931 and passed through this life on December 11, 2012 in Paterson, New Jersey after a lengthy illness.

Lloyd was the oldest child of the seven children born to the late Lloyd Carter, Sr. and Bertha Thomas Carter. He was the brother of Lillian, James (Jimmy), Rubin, Beverly, Rosalie and Doris. Lloyd was married and he was the father of four children, Lloyd Hal, Rhonda, Gary and Antoine.

At an early age, Lloyd joined St. Paul Baptist Church and he was baptized under the auspices of the late Rev. T.M. Carter. Many years later he faithfully served as chairman of the trustee board. He also was a former member of Mt. Olive Baptist Church of Glassboro.

Lloyd attended school in Paterson and when he was old enough he joined the military and served in the Air Force during the Korean War where he was honorably discharged. Lloyd worked at U.S. Rubber in Passaic, NJ, Progressive Life Insurance Company, Division of Motor Vehicle, City of Paterson Board of Recreation, O.I.C., Moods Farm in South Jersey. He also was in charge of many of the Carter Family's business ventures.

Lloyd loved to watch television, especially the ball games. He liked to play cards and he loved to play two handed pinnacle. Five days a week Lloyd faithfully attended Seneon where he established the repetition of being the bingo king. He was a quit fellow that would talk to you if you would start the conversation. Lloyd enjoyed being with his family and he was the banker to many in the family. He was very special to his sister, Doris who caring for him brought meaning into her life. He lived with Lillian and Doris for twenty-one years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Lloyd and Bertha Carter, son, Lloyd Hal Carter and brother, James A. Carter.

Lloyd will be missed by all those who knew him who loved him.
