

Andrew Ragland was born on July 17, 1927 in Lincoln, Alabama to the late Harvey Ragland and Mary Etta Thornton Ragland.

On Wednesday, December 26, 2012 at Montefiore Hospital in Bronx, NY, God in his special way, at his perfect time picked from our midst his precious soul and added him to his Heavenly garden where his spirit will continue to live forever.

Andrew Ragland decided to serve his country by enlisting in the United States Navy in 1945. Serving for three years and then re-enlisted in the Air Force in 1948 where he would serve for twenty-four years and retire. Andrew returned in 1956 to raise his oldest son and eventually three more children to follow.
