Reflections of Life

Annie Lee Fedd was born to the late Eddie and Mandy Johnson on December 7, 1921 in Cochran, Georgia. She departed this life on Friday, February 8, 2013 after a lengthy stay at Regency Gardens Nursing Center, Wayne, New Jersey.

Annie received her education in the Cochran, Georgia School System. At an early age, she accepted Christ as her personal savior and with the guidance of her mother and father; she became a member of the Piney Grove Baptist Church.

Annie was in her late teens when she and her childhood sweetheart Everett Fedd decided to marry. They relocated to Passaic, New Jersey in 1944. They were a happy couple who looked forward to having many children, but unfortunately that was not to be because in 1952 Everett was fatally injured.

Missing her husband and needing to fill the void in her life, Annie found a job working at the Silk-O-Lite Company in Garfield, New Jersey, and was employed there for more than 40 years. 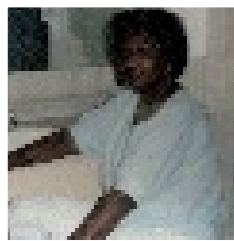
