Remembering Elizabeth

Elder Elizabeth Jones, daughter of the late Samuel Akins and Sadie Akins Jones, was born on September 3, 1932 in Pocatigo, South Carolina. After Elizabeth's birth her parents moved to Savannah, Georgia.

Growing up Elizabeth was blessed to have strong influences by her spiritual parents, Bishop Albert and Edna Kelly Owens of Owens Temple First Christ Holiness Church in Savannah, Georgia. At an early age, she accepted Jesus Christ in her heart and began working diligently in the church. Her ultimate purpose was to show God's love, acceptance and patience to all who entered her life, especially to her children.

Her conviction to God's purpose on the earth compelled her to esteem others higher than herself so often denying herself to make sure others were encouraged, edified, and built up. Whenever it was in her power she would spend endless hours strategizing to find ways to help someone who had a pressing need. Elder (Mother) Jones was marked by her contagious smile and joy as she greeted everyone with tender kindness.
