Lounett Roberson was born on January 13, 1939 in Chickasaw, Mississippi, daughter of Henretta Wilson Wright and John Thomas Wright.

She was educated in the Aberdeen, Mississippi Public School System and graduated from high school there. She continued her education in the fields of nursing and the ministry.

Lounett became a licensed Evangelist through the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. on April 7, 1989 and studied at Aeon Bible College. She served as Evangelist at Bethesda Temple Church of the Apostolic Faith, Inc. in Normandy, Missouri. She became a certified Missouri Correctional Chaplain in September of 1991. She also received a Certificate of Sunday School Training on March 22, 1992 and in the same year, received a Volunteers In Correction Certificate from the Central Missouri Correction Center.

Mrs. Roberson was a nurse at a hospital in Missouri for many years.

Her artistic talents were rewarded with a Certificate of Merit from the Talent and Associated Companies in recognition of outstanding lyric writing.

Evangelist Lounett Roberson departed this life on Friday, April 12, 2013 at Trinitas Hospital in Elizabeth, New Jersey at the age of seventy-four. She was predeceased by her husband, Philipp Roberson, Jr., siblings, Theophis Wright, Levi Wright, Kelvin Wright, Annie Pearl King, John Thomas Wright, Levell Wright and Willie B. Wright.
