Remembering Hugh

Hugh Gregory Potts, Sr., was born on October 21, 1957 in Elizabeth, New Jersey, son of Ruthie M. Towler and Edward J. Potts, Jr. He was a lifelong resident of Linden. Hugh graduated from Linden High School in the Class of 1976.

He was an excellent musician and played for many churches including Emmanuel Tabernacle Assembly of God and First Baptist Church both in Linden, St. Matthew Baptist Church and Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church both in Roselle and Mt. Zion AME Church of Plainfield just to name a few. At the present time, he was the Minister of Music at Heard A. M. E. Church in Roselle for three years and was also the Organist for G.G. Woody Funeral Home

Hugh was a songwriter, music producer, and composer. He was the CEO of *Hughnique Music Productions* in Linden. He received numerous awards for his diverse musical talents such as the New Jersey State award for the First Saxophone Seat. Hugh enjoyed playing the organ, keyboard, clarinet, flute and guitar. He would always say he could play every instrument "except the drums".

He was an actor who made appearances on several television shows. At the time of his passing, he was in a production of the upcoming movie, *The Amazing Spiderman 2*.

Hugh was a classy musician, gentle giant, and a sharp dresser who will surely be missed by his family, friends and the community.

He was predeceased by his brother, Thomas L. Towler and niece, Tamara E. Towler. Hugh Gregory Potts, Sr. passed away suddenly on Saturday, April 13, 2013 at Rahway Hospital in Rahway.
