“O Praise Ye The Lord” - Hymn 20

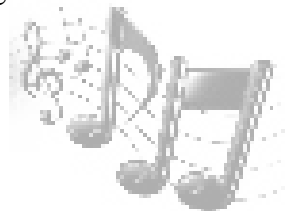


O praise ye the Lord!
