## <u>Life Reflections</u>

Early in her youth, the family moved to Fuquay Springs, North Carolina where she was educated in the Wake County Public School System. Upon graduation from Fuquay Consolidated High School, Mattie continued her education at Livingston College in Salisbury, North Carolina and North Carolina Central University in Durham, North Carolina.
