Dr. Lorraine Anna Laneuville Jones MD passed on July 4th at home in Plainfield. Born in New Orleans, LA., she has been a resident of Plainfield for fifty-two years and a member of St. Mary's RCC.

Dr. Jones was in private practice as a pediatrician for over seventy years and served the Plainfield community in many ways. Among her accomplishments she was a graduate of Xavier University (BS Degree), New Orleans, LA., the Meharry Medical College (MD)

Nashville, TN., her hospital training was at the Flint Goodridge Hospital, New Orleans, and the Hanimann Hospital in Scranton, PA., the Trustee for the Board of Governors & the Dept. of Pediatrics at Muhlenberg RMC, one of the principle founders of the Plainfield Health Clinic, Vice Chairperson of the Muhlenberg Nursing School, founder and president of the 700 Block Association in Plainfield, president and founder of the Xavier University Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority in New Orleans, Trustee for both the John Runnells Hospital in Berkeley Hgts., and the Visiting Nurses Association of Plainfield and Scotch Plains, The Plainfield Board of Health for sixteen years, the Plainfield Health Center Pediatrician, served with the "Well Baby Station" of Plainfield & Scotch Plains, The Plainfield Red Cross, founder and past president of the Grant Ave. Community Center, past president and member of the MRS Club

Inc. and many other health and civic organizations, as well as, the recipient of numerous awards for her service to the community and state.

She is survived by her husband of sixty-eight years, Charles Jones Jr.; sons, Charles A. Jones III (Jenovena) and Michael A. Jones; daughter, Gueringer "Gari" Jones-Dabney; six grandchildren, Ava Laneuville Joseph (Wesly), Remi and Wayne Jr., Khary Dabney, Aaron and Christian Jones; one great grandson, Ethan Joseph; sisters, Marilyn Populus (William) and Joan Armour (Charles); and a host of loving relatives and friends.
