Reflections of Life

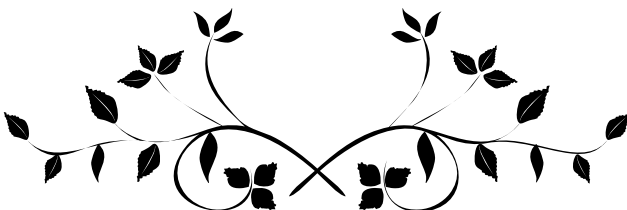
Felicia R. Primus, was born on December 19, 1948 to the late Millege and Rose (Brown) Primus.
