Fannie Grant was born on February 5, 1920 to Walter and Viola Parrish in Mecklenberg County, Virginia. She, along with her mother and two brothers (Jessie and Al) migrated North and settled in Orange, NJ when she was nine years old. She attended the Orange Public School system and graduated from Orange High School in 1938.

On November 22, 1940 Fannie married William Grant and from that union she gave birth to three children; Phyllis, Dolores, and William. Fannie was employed for many years at Orange Memorial Hospital and later retired from Overbrook Hospital in Cedar Grove, NJ. She was a long time member at Bethel Baptist Church in Orange, where she was part of the Senior Choir and could always be found at various events with her Church family.
