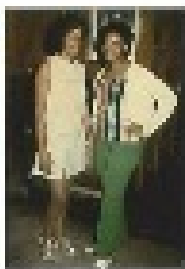
Henrietta Marie Skipper departed this life on Sunday, December 8, 2013 at home surrounded by her family.
