Olivia Crews Weathersbe, daughter of the late Norman “Nick” Crews and Helen Royster Crews, was born on November 18, 1950, in Oxford, North Carolina. On Friday, December 13, 2013, Olivia said that I am tired and heard God calling and went to be with him.

Olivia was educated in the Vance County schools. She was a 1970 graduate of Henderson Institute High School in Henderson, North Carolina. Immediately after High School, Olivia further pursued her education by taking nursing courses which she received a Nursing Certificate.
