Organist Lyn F. Peachey was born February 21, 1942 in Brooklyn, New York and died in Wilmington, Delaware on Friday, December 20, 2013, at the age of 71.

Lyn F. She has a long list of accomplishments including playing her first Bach piece at two years old. Lyn began teaching piano at the age of six, studied at MBC studios since the age of five. At age eight, she was the organist at the Offspring Baptist Church in Brooklyn, NY. In one of many of her newspaper articles it stated "the little genius memorized 10 pieces for her auditions at Julliard playing Bach, Chopin, Mozart, and Beethoven with alacrity and received the highest average of 96%". Lyn attended The High School of Performing Arts in 1954 And The Guilmant Organ School in NY. Lyn taught Music/Theory at the St. Peter Claver School in Queens, NY and St. Joseph's Episcopal Church School. She also worked for several churches and funeral homes requested for weddings and funerals. She retired from St. Joseph's Episcopal Church after 30 years serving as Organist of the music ministry. Lyn F. Peachey traveled and played all over the world. She was gifted beyond her years and touched the lives of the many.

Lyn enjoyed writing and playing music, playing Word with Friends on her Kindle, and reading. On December 20, 2013, God brought another angel into the heavens. Lyn will be truly missed.
