Obituary

Paul Anthony Coleman was born on June 30, 1966 in Brooklyn, New York to Paul and Carole Coleman. At age six, he and his family moved to Orange, New Jersey. Paul met his wife, Kecia in 1989 and they were married December 24, 1994. Anthony (as he was called by his family) was bright, energetic, and friendly as a child and into adulthood.

As a child, Anthony attended Heywood Avenue Grammar School, Our Lady of the Valley School and Bloomfield Technical Vocational High School. After graduating from high school and receiving a certificate in electrical engineering, he used his skills to further his career at Warnock Automotive Group in East Hanover, New Jersey where he worked for seventeen years.
