

<u>Obituary</u>

Michael John Lewis was born to Adrian Lewis and Edna Taylor Lewis on December 28, 1950 on the Island of Trinidad.

Michael was baptized as a Seventh Day Adventist. As a teenager, he excelled in swimming and was selected to participate in the Special Olympics Trials but did not meet the medical requirements due to cardiac abnormalities.

He immigrated to the United States in 1994. Later on he attended services at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church where he relentlessly pursued Pastor Thom after services, to bless his tongue to make him speak. He attended the Occupational Center in East Orange on a voluntary basis, and was also very involved in the evening programs and social activities at the West Orange and South Orange Recreational Centers for the disabled. He received a certificate of achievement as an outstanding member of the Canteen Club at the South Orange Club where he also received several awards and prizes for dancing, karate and Halloween competitions.

Michael suffered for many years from kidney disease yet endured it without complaint. Over the past year, however, his illness progressed and he was treated at East Orange General Hospital, where he passed away on January 13, 2014.

He is predeceased by his parents and sister, Arlene Williams.

Michael is survived by siblings Owen, Joan, Earle, Yolande, Ann, Peter, David, Ian, Penny, and Margaret, and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.
