Obituary

My Aunt, my friend, **Hearties Fraser-Minott**; nickname Winnie, was a great strong woman. She was dearly loved by all especially her brothers, sisters, in-laws, nieces, nephews and friends. Although she came from simple beginnings, Hearties worked her way through school and had a long successful career. Hard work and determination characterized this strong and loving wife, aunt and sister. She was the 6th child of 10 children, born to Roland and Albertha Fraser on a Farm in Fullerton Park District, St. Ann's Jamaica West Indies.

It was a beautiful day of February 14, 1939 Albertha recorded in her diary, that all of their relatives and neighbors from the surrounding had gathered to greet the baby girl. Perhaps as her father and mother looked at the time, they were reminded of the life and growth awaiting their new daughter. Her childhood is best described as both humble and proud. During her years at Eccleston Primary School, Hearties met Granville whom she would later marry. After leaving school, Hearties went on to work at James Law Office in Kingston, Jamaica W. I. as a Secretary, where she worked for 10 years.

Later on she migrated to the United States of America in December 1984, where she pursue her career and worked as a Certified Nursing Assistant. Hearties was very active in her church where she serve as a Missionary at the Messiah Baptist Church.

In late 2005 were the time of the tragic discovery of cancer that took her life. Hearties was a healthy 74 years old. Unlike many woman her age, who are confined to wheelchairs or depend upon assisted living. Hearties would go out to do her walks, grocery shopping, pay her bills and going to church everyday. She cherished her independence. Her favorite words were: "Camille, you don't ask your father about the Frasers?, we are proud people." "We don't take handouts." She fought this battle until the very end.

She was loved very much and we will miss her dearly. Her lifetime of dedication and self-sacrifice serve as a monument to the exemplary woman she was. Her humility, integrity, and hard work continue to inspire those who knew her.

She left behind her loving brothers and sisters to mourn her loss: Emeyroy, Wesley, Gerald, Oscar, Pearl, Adlin, Olive, and Gloria. Brother-in-law: Abraham, surviving husband Granville Minott. Also her friends who stood by her until the very end. I would like to say a special thanks to Pearl, Joe, Brown, Joyce and Dorothy.
