Brian was born on January 20, 1992 in Paterson, NJ to Brenda (Williams) Crockett (deceased) and Franklin D. Crockett, Jr. He was a lifelong, active

member of the Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Passaic, NJ. His love of the Lord prepared him for life. Brian graduated from St. Mary's High School in Rutherford, NJ and Colgate University in Hamilton, NY, he majored in Educational Studies. During these years, Brian also excelled athletically. At St. Mary's, Brian played offensive and defensive tackle in football and was a two-time all Bergen County Scholastic League (BCSL) selection. He also wrestled capturing the District 16 wrestling title. At Colgate, Brian played offensive line and was selected to 1st Team, All league in Division I-AA Patriot League and 2nd Team - All American the last season. He also

helped lead the Colgate Raiders to their 7th League
Title. During his time at Colgate, he partnered
with several organizations to raise awareness of
rare diseases, getting students/athletes involved
with surrounding communities, and supporting a
diverse learning community through the Black
Student Union and Brothers Association. Brian
also co-founded the Colgate Athletic Bible Study
Group which grew from 7 to 30 attendees. He
received numerous awards among them from
Passaic Youth Empowerment, Inc., National Young
Leaders Conference and the NAACP (Passaic
Branch). His work was not in vain.

Most recently he joined the staff at Williston Northampton School in Easthampton, Massachusetts, becoming a beloved colleague, teacher, coach and friend. Brian taught History and Global Studies and of course, coached football, wrestling and track.

Brian was predeceased by his mother, Brenda; his grandmother, Annie M. Williams and his grandfather, Franklin D. Crockett, Sr.
